



**10th FIPS-Mouche Youth World Fly Fishing Championships
and Conservation Symposium
Tuscany, ITALY, 27 August –3 September 2011**

RULE MODIFICATIONS

FIPS-Mouche has appointed Italy to be the host country for the 10th FIPS-Mouche Youth World Fly Fishing Championship and Conservation Symposium to be held in the Tuscany region in Italy. These Rule Modifications apply to the 2009 FIPS-Mouche Competition Rules.

ARTICLE 2: GENERAL INFORMATION

2.2. Add: Five sessions will be held on rivers: bank fishing, wading allowed.
Annex A Rotation Matrix.

ARTICLE 9: BANK FISHING COMPETITIONS

9.3. Add: The beats on the river will be an average of 120 m with a buffer zone of 5 m on each side.

Add New 9.6: Wading in river is allowed in all sessions and chest waders may be worn.

28.5 New: During river fishing only ONE fly is allowed

ARTICLE 11: DURATION OF THE EVENTS, AND SCORING AND PRACTICE SESSIONS

11.3. Add: The hours for fishing will be 09.00-12.00 and 16:30-19:30h.

11.4. Add: All practice will be catch and release.

ARTICLE 24: ELIGIBLE FISH

Add new 24.4. The fish will be measured from the tip of the nose to the extremities of the tail, squeezed together. Size limit is 20 cm

The eligible fish will be:

Grayling (*Thymallus thymallus*)

Brown trout (*Salmo trutta m. lacustris*)

Rainbow Trout (*Oncorhynchus mykiss*)

ARTICLE 28: COMPETITION FLIES

Add new 28.1.1 On sector V (Lower Tevere) only One Dry Fly is allowed.

Change 28.5 Only one fly is allowed during the championship
